PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: The Blackfeet Tribal Business Council is the duly, constituted, governing body within the exterior boundaries of the Blackfeet Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS: The Blackfeet Tribal Business Council has been organized to represent, develop, protect, and advance the views, interests, and resources of the Blackfeet Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS: The enumerated powers of the Blackfeet Tribal Business Council contact in Article VI, section 1 (g) of the Blackfeet Constitution include management of Tribal Affairs in an acceptable and business-like manner, and

WHEREAS: On March 15, 2020, pursuant to Resolution 300-2009, Chairman Timothy Davis issued an Emergency Declaration to begin the engagement of the Blackfeet Tribe's Emergency Plan with all entities and jurisdictions affecting the Blackfeet Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS: On March 16, 2020, the Blackfeet Tribal Business Council adopted Resolution 181-2020 in response to the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) outbreak that posed a threat to the Blackfeet Indian Reservation and reaffirmed the Emergency Declaration by Chairman Timothy Davis of March 15, 2020 and set forth efforts to "flatten the curve" of the COVID-19 outbreak, and

NOW, THEREFORE THE BLACKFEET TRIBAL BUSINESS COUNCIL THROUGH THEIR EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, DOES HEREBY SET FORTH THE ORDERS IN THIS PROCLAMATION FOR THE BLACKFEET TRIBE OF THE BLACKFEET INDIAN RESERVATION:

1. The reservation wide curfew shall continue from **10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.** daily. 1st Offense shall be a warning; 2nd Offense shall be a citation with a fine.

2. All Blackfeet Tribal Offices & Buildings shall remain closed until further notice. Extensive cleaning is being done at all the Tribal Buildings and employees are directed to not be in the buildings. Only Essential Emergency Personnel are allowed at this time.
3. Alcohol sales on the Blackfeet Reservation shall be 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. until further notice.
4. All borders and roads accessing Glacier National Park from the Blackfeet Reservation are hereby closed due to the health and safety of the Blackfeet Tribe until further notice.
5. Residents are encouraged to shelter in their homes, leaving only when they must.
6. All Tribal ^{Everyone} Employees who have traveled to a confirmed COVID-19 "hot spot" are required to self-quarantine for 14 days. Also, any Tribal Employees violating the Resolution 181-2020 or this Proclamation shall forfeit their Administrative Leave and will be dealt with administratively.
7. The elderly and those with compromised immune systems/vulnerable are to remain indoors unless they need medical attention or essentials.
8. Wash your hands regularly and please practice good hygiene. If you are sick you are asked to please remain at home.
