RESOLUTION

Approving CARES Act Funds to Compensate Glacier Family Foods Employees for Hazard Pay

Resolution No. 283-2020

- WHEREAS,** The Blackfeet Tribal Business Council is the duly constituted governing body within the exterior boundaries of the Blackfeet Indian Nation pursuant to Section 16 of Act of June 18, 1934 and Amendments thereof, and
- WHEREAS,** The Blackfeet Tribal Business Council has been organized to represent, develop, protect and advance the views, interests, and resources education and resources of the Blackfeet Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS,** The Blackfeet Tribal Business Council is empowered, pursuant to Article VI-Powers of the Council, Section 1(e) to manage all economic affairs and enterprises of the Blackfeet Reservation; and, Section 1(g) to manage tribal affairs in an acceptable and businesslike manner and in accordance with the administrative plan called the Plan of Operations; and, Section 1(k) to promulgate ordinances for the purposes of safeguarding the peace and safety of residents of the Blackfeet Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS,** The Blackfeet Tribal Business Council passed the *“Blackfeet Tribe COVID-19 Ordinance” No. 121* and *Resolution No. 2020-181 “Reaffirming the Declaration Addressing the COVID-19 Outbreak for the Blackfeet Reservation”* to limit the risk of infection from the global pandemic outbreak of COVID-19 to members and residents of the Blackfeet Reservation, and
- WHEREAS,** The Blackfeet Tribe’s Business entity, Siyeh Corporation operates Glacier Family

Foods, a tribal store on behalf of the Blackfeet Tribe and currently employs a number of food-industry workers that were not able to be funded for hazard pay under the Blackfeet Tribe as Siyeh Corporation is a separated entity of the Blackfeet Tribe, and


WHEREAS, Siyeh Corporation has requested the Blackfeet Tribal Business Council to provide hazard pay to Glacier Family Foods employees due to their constant contact with the public, the handling of food and regular contact with commonly used surfaces, to which presents a high risk of infection COVID-19, and

WHEREAS, The Blackfeet Tribal Business Council hereby desires to approve CARES Act funds to Siyeh Corporation to cover hazard pay compensation to the employees of Glacier Family Foods until December 30, 2020, now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Approval of Hazard Pay for Siyeh Corporation, Glacier Family Foods Employees.
That the Blackfeet Tribal Business Council hereby approves Hazard Pay to Siyeh Corporation for Glacier Family Foods employees, pursuant to Siyeh Corporation Hazard Pay Policies, out of the Treasury CARES Act Funding for the Blackfeet Tribe until December 30, 2020. The final amount shall be approved by the Blackfeet Tribal Business Council once the total for this period is determined. Payment of this compensation shall be done on a reimbursement basis from the Treasurer.
2. The Chairman or the Vice-Chairman in the Chairman's absence and the Secretary of the Blackfeet Tribal Business Council are hereby authorized to sign this Resolution and any other documents to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution.


